Leroy Cecil Grainger was born in Conway, SC, a son of the late Joseph LeRoy Grainger and Ruth Graham Grainger. He graduated from Conway High School and Clemson University, and was an Army veteran of the Korean War. Mr. Grainger served the North Conway Baptist Church for many years as a faithful member, Sunday School Teacher/Director and Deacon.

For over 40 years, Mr. Grainger owned The Grainger Companies, Inc., an Insurance and Real Estate business. He served the Coastal Carolina Association of Realtors, the Conway Board of Realtors and the Horry County Board of Realtors as President, Vice President, and Director, as well as on numerous committees. He was honored by the CCAR with their Realtor Image Award and was named Realtor of the Year. He served the South Carolina Association of Realtors as Vice President, Treasurer, and State Director. He was President of the Conway Jaycees and named their Outstanding Young Man of the Year. He served as President of the Horry Georgetown Home Builders Association, on the Board of the Partners for Economic Development and the Waccamaw Community Development Corporation. He was also Chairman of Horry County Republican Party and served many years with the Gideons International as Camp President, Vice President and Membership

Chairman.

Mr. Grainger was predeceased by his wife of 57 years, Sarah G. Grainger; his brothers, Waterman, A. D. and Lavern; and his sisters, Edna Moore, Pearlina "Connie" James, Evelyn Bailes, Frances Watts, and Esterlene Renfroe.

Survivors include his sons, Gavin (Laura) Grainger and Garon (Mary) Grainger; his granddaughters, Katie, Emma, Grayson and Gentry Grainger; and many nieces and nephews.

The funeral service will be held at 11:00AM Friday, May 18, 2018 at North Conway Baptist Church, officiated by Dr. Jeffrey L. Gaskins. Burial will follow at Graham Cemetery. The family will receive friends in the church fellowship hall at 10:00AM.
