MSgt Leslie "Bud" Gorton (Ret), age 69, died on Tuesday, October 15, 2013 at Tideland's Hospice House in Georgetown, SC.

Born in Lansing, MI, Bud was a son of the late Harold and Helen Gorton. Bud served in the US Air Force for 1963 to 1989. While serving in Vietnam in 1969 he received the Bronze Star for meritorious service. He also received the Tactical Air Command's Information Systems Program Manager of the Year in 1986. Bud attended church at Surfside Beach Christian Church. He delivered the mail at the Lakes and was well loved.

Survivors include his wife of 47 years, Claudine Gorton of Myrtle Beach; a daughter Dorothee, son Frederic; grandchildren Eric and wife Gwen, Natasha, Melissa and Renee, Andrew and Roger; great grandson Bryson; sisters from Michigan Mary, Louise and husband Chet, Peggy, Penny and husband Rick; best friends Hugh and Sue, Nicole and Jean Marie, numerous nieces and nephews here and in France.

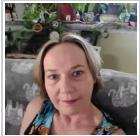

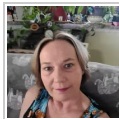

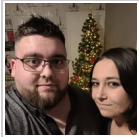
