



Lewis A. Langdon

July 27, 1929 - November 9, 2019

Mr. Lewis A. Langdon, 90, husband of Jacqueline C. Langdon, passed away Saturday, November 9, 2019 at Embrace Hospice House following a brief illness.

Born July 27, 1929 in Washington, DC, he was the son of the late John Edwin Langdon and the late Marian Mae Talbott Langdon. Mr. Langdon served in the USMC during WWII and was a retired firefighter with 30 years of service with the District of Columbia Fire Department, 9 Engine. In 1979, upon retirement, Lou and his family relocated to South Carolina where he enjoyed the warmer temperatures and his life-long passion for golf. He was a member of First Baptist Church of Conway where he served as an usher and member of the Anglers Sunday School Class. He was also a lifetime member of the 1st Marine Division and the Centennial Masonic Lodge #174 in Upper Marlboro, MD.
