Conway...Lila Ruth Chryst, 97, wife of the late Lacy A. Chryst, died Saturday, January 4, 2014 at Conway Manor.

Mrs. Chryst was born in Conway, a daughter of the late Henry Clay and Effie Singleton Lundy. She was a member of the First Baptist Church and Dorcas Sunday School Class.
