Linda Weeks Gangi, age 71, passed away peacefully on March 2, 2026, surrounded by her loving family. She was born on March 19, 1954, in Stillwater, Oklahoma. Linda graduated from Clinton High School in Clinton, North Carolina, before earning her undergraduate degree from the University of North Carolina. She went on to receive her Juris Doctor from the University of South Carolina.

Linda practiced law for more than 40 years at Thompson & Henry Law Firm in Conway, South Carolina, before retiring to her home in Ocean Isle Beach, North Carolina. She was known as a fierce litigator and was a trailblazer as one of the few female attorneys in South Carolina when she began her career in 1979.

While Linda was proud of her professional achievements, her greatest joy was being a mother to Ashley, Glenn, and Christine and Gigi to her grandson, "sweet baby James." Nothing made her prouder than her children, and she was thrilled to become a grandmother to James, a role she cherished deeply. She never missed an opportunity to celebrate them and their accomplishments. Linda also had a great love for animals, especially her beloved dogs, Cooper and Mocha—and was a lifelong UNC sports fan.
