Liston B. Edge, age 81, passed away on Saturday, October 12, 2024.

Born December 14, 1942 in Horry County, he was the son of the late Harvey and Lessie Edge. Mr. Edge was a graduate of Conway High School and Clemson University. After college, he entered the Air Force as an Electronic Engineer and First Lieutenant specializing in Electronic Warfare. During his service, he was promoted to Captain and piloted B52 planes. He was part of the Combat Crew and served in the Vietnam War. Mr. Edge was awarded The Pride Award for Outstanding Performance by the United States Air Force and The Air Medal for Meritorious Achievement in Aerial Flight from the President of the United States. Mr. Edge was the owner and operator of Carpet Wholesale for over 40 years. He was a member of New Home Baptist Church.

Along with his parents, he was predeceased by his wife Ivadean S. Edge and brother H.C. Edge, Jr. Surviving are brothers and sisters in law Carl and Gloria Foxworth, Roger and Wanda Shannon, and Brenda Shannon; nieces and nephews; and great nieces and nephews.
