Lois Jane Ebner Briggs, 81, went home to be with her heavenly father on Friday, January 19, 2018. Lois was born in Sandusky, Ohio on April 20, 1936, the eldest daughter of the late Lewis and Augusta Ebner. She graduated from Sandusky High School in 1954 and married James Robert Briggs in 1958. Lois and family moved to South Carolina in 1973.
