Lois was born in Darlington, South Carolina and she moved to Conway at an early age with her family. She graduated from Conway High School and the University Of South Carolina School Of Nursing with honors. She had a long career as a registered nurse committing her life to patient care especially in the area of dialysis. She became the Director of Nursing for Fresenius Kidney Care and supervised the opening of a number of dialysis clinics in Horry County.

Lois was an active life-long member of Bethlehem Baptist Church; she loved studying the Bible. She graduated from Langston Bible Institute, and she was a skilled and beloved teacher for adults and children. She particularly enjoyed incorporating historical background into adult lessons and helping children with their knowledge and application of scripture through the Bible drill

program.
