Dr. L. Bradford Courtney, age 77, died peacefully Friday morning, January 11, 2013 at his home, overlooking the Great Pee Dee River. Born in the Couchton Community of Aiken he was predeceased by his parents Clarence Cosmo and Willie Burckhalter Courtney.

Dr. Courtney was a graduate of Aiken High School, University of South Carolina and a 1961 graduate of the Medical University of South Carolina. He was a beloved pediatrician and cared for generations of children at Conway Pediatrics for over 48 years. He was a member of Kingston Presbyterian Church. Dr. Courtney served in the United States Navy as a Lt. Commander during the Vietnam War.

Dr. Courtney was predeceased by his beloved first wife, Carolyn Nelson Fortson Courtney; brothers, Clarence Courtney, Jr., Gordon Courtney, Leslie Courtney; and a sister, Martha Courtney Woodruff.
