Conway... Muldrow Jackson "Bud" Edge, age 92, passed away peacefully at his home on Sunday, November 25, 2018. The son of W.B. Edge, Sr. and Tempie Ricks Edge, he was born in 1926 and was raised with eight siblings at the family home place where he spent the last 34 years.

He was a 1943 graduate of Socastee High School and earned an Associate's Degree in Business Administration from Columbia Commercial College; where he met and married Hazel Winn Edge in 1949 until her passing in 2012. Mr. Edge was a decorated WWII Army Veteran being awarded the Bronze Star for meritorious achievement in ground combat against the enemy. He was a retired Family Counselor for Alcohol and Drug Abuse in Columbia, Lancaster, and Conway. Mr. Edge was a member of the 12 Step Self-Help Program since 1967. He was a mentor to many and full of good advice and humor, traits that he shared with many great friends throughout his life. Mr. Edge was predeceased by his wife, Hazel Winn Edge, four brothers, and four sisters.

He is survived by one son, Buddy Edge (Brenda) of McCormick; two daughters, Delores "Dee" Nolan of Wytheville, VA, and Nancy "JoJo" Kibler (Randy) of Spartanburg; one sister-in-law, Elizabeth "Woogie" James of Socastee; six grandchildren; eleven great-grandchildren; a special niece, Gwen Edge; a special nephew, Timmy Edge; and many loving friends and extended AA family.
