



## Macon Arthur

Pawleys Island Macon Arthur, age 84 passed away Monday, April 9, 2006 after a short illness. Mr. Arthur was born on March 1, 1922 in Goldsboro, NC, he was the son of the late Sara Michaux Arthur and Colonel Joseph Dogan Arthur. He attended the University of Virginia where he received his undergraduate and law degrees. Mr. Arthur served in the US Army during World War II as a combat engineer, first in Europe, where he participated in campaigns in Normandy and Eastern France. He then served in the Phillippines and Japan. He retired as a Major in the Army Reserves. Mr. Arthur practiced law in Washington, DC, Chicago, IL and Paris, France. He was a partner in the Chicago law firm of Mayer, Brown and Platt until 1984. After retiring to SC in 1984, he served as a Director of the Arthur State Bank in Union, SC. Mr. Arthur was preceded in death by his brother, Dogan Arthur and sister, Nancy Arthur Smith. Surviving are his wife, Marianne de Roubaix Arthur, children, Patrick Arthur of Middletown, MD, Danielle Lucca of McLean, VA, Elizabeth Hamilton of Lake Forest, IL; brother, Dr. Robert Arthur of Richmond, VA and six grandchildren. Memorial services will be announced at a later date. Interment will be in Arlington National Cemetery.
