Mae Eason Hucks, age 73, wife of the late Joseph Harmon Hucks, Jr., passed away Wednesday, August 3, 2016 at her residence.

Mrs. Hucks was born in Conway, SC, a daughter of the late Richard Cravon Eason and Charlotte Ruth Paul Eason. In addition to her parents and husband; she was also preceded in death by her brother, Wilson Eason.

Mrs. Hucks was a 1961 graduate of Conway High School and also was a 1965 graduate of Winthrop College. She was a passionate educator for Horry County School District for many years having taught at Conway, Aynor, and also North Myrtle Beach High Schools.
