



Major (Ret.) Harold (Hal) R. Franklin Jr.

Born Cleveland Ohio, the son of Amelia (Castragano), and Harold R Franklin Sr.

Hal joined the US Army in April 1959, and knew immediately he was where he belonged and dedicated his life to the military.

During his first overseas duty station in Augsburg Germany he became a highly decorated member of the LeClerc Rifle Team. After returning stateside he completed Ranger school, Jump school, Flight school, and Officer Candidate school. He received The Soldier of the Year Award, for the 11th Air Assault Division, and proudly served with the 101st Airborne "Screaming Eagles" which remained his favorite unit throughout his 20 year career.

He served in Viet Nam, and received the Purple Heart.

Hal lived by the Ranger Creed, shouldering more than his share of the task, whatever it might be. 100% and then some.

After retirement from the Army, he started Army JROTC programs at Leone High School, American Samoa, and Green Sea Floyds High School, SC.

After JROTC Hal and Barbara started their rental business in Garden City SC. It brought people into their lives that became treasured longtime friends.

Hal had a passion for life, and he lived it without regret. He valued the friends he made, and touched so many lives with his kindness, compassion, strength, and sense of humor. He was quiet and reserved, but always observant and insightful. He loved his family, traveling, fishing, the beach, and good bourbon.

His is predeceased by his parents Amelia and Harold, his sister Carol Ann Clemence, and his son Harold M Franklin.

He is survived by his wife of 48 years, Barbara. 2 daughters, Renee Franklin and Laura Sweirski. Grandchildren, Hannah Davisson, Raymond Franklin-Cruz, Jennifer, Jessica, and Julia Rose. Six great grand children, three nieces, a nephew, one uncle, and many cousins.

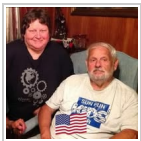

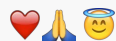
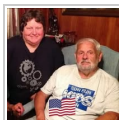
