She was a 60 year member of the First United Methodist Church where she was a former Sunday School Teacher and leader of the Juniors. Mrs. Goldfinch was a member of the United Methodist Women and the Bessie Henry Circle . She attended Lander College in 1937 and graduated from McLeod School of Nursing in 1941. As a Registered Nurse, Mrs. Goldfinch joined the U.S. Army Air Corps as a First Lieutenant serving in World War II. Mrs. Goldfinch took an active part in the life of her community and was an honorary member of the Conway Kiwanis Club. She was one of the founding leaders of the Girl Scout Council of the Pee Dee . She served as Scout Leader, Neighborhood Chairman and District Chairman. In 1964, she was presented with the Thanks Badge, Girl Scouts highest honor for her work on the organization?s behalf. 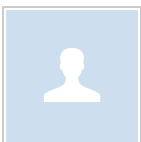
