Margaret M. Flood, age 73, died on Thursday, July 28, 2016 in the SICU at Grand Strand Medical Center in Myrtle Beach, SC. She passed peacefully surrounded by family after struggling to recover from surgeries associated with abscessed diverticuli.

Margaret was born in Windsor, England to Gerald and Ena Tyler, and was the youngest of three children. She came to America on July 30, 1962 to meet Elvis, her favorite musician but instead ended up falling in love with and marrying Richard Flood, her husband of 53 years. Margaret worked for many years at Wachovia and had a passion for reading, traveling, gardening and the beach but truly cherished the time she had with her grandchildren Owen and Grace.

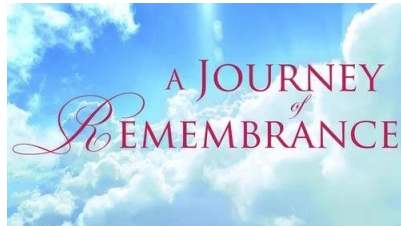
