



## Marion Cannon

Myrtle Beach, SC--Rev. Marion C. Cannon, Sr., age 73, of Ashwood Lane, passed away peacefully at his home in Myrtle Beach on Saturday, April 17, 2010. Rev. Cannon was born in Hemingway, SC on February 4, 1937, the only son of the late Rev. Marvin O. Cannon and Elizabeth Powell Cannon. Marion graduated with honors from Hemingway High School in 1955, and attended Holmes Bible College. He was ordained as a minister in 1960. His first pastorate was North Pentecostal Holiness Church in North, South Carolina. He was transferred to Myrtle Beach in 1962 where he pastored Kingsway Pentecostal Holiness Church for 13 years. From 1992 to 1997, Marion pastored Faith Temple in Myrtle Beach. Marion also worked as a leader in the Myrtle Beach business community in the development of residential and commercial real estate. He was predeceased by his wife, Hilda Boland Cannon, and his daughter, Sherri Elizabeth Cannon. He is survived by his wife of 32 years, Mary Benton Cannon, of the home, his son, Chuck Cannon and his wife, Lari and their children, M'Kenzy, Jaxon and Kyra of Nashville, TN, his daughter, Renee Cannon Cox and her husband, Larry of Nashville, TN, his two sisters, Gladys Cannon Ganey and her husband, Rev. Jim Ganey of Franklin Springs, GA, and Christine Cannon Branham and her husband, Larry Branham of Elgin, SC. Also surviving are his uncles, Doris Cannon and his wife, Lucille of Rockingham, NC and W.A. Powell, Sr. and his wife, Edith of Andrews, SC, as well as his aunt, Kathleen Powell Carter of Bonneau, SC and numerous nieces and nephews. Funeral services will be held at 2:00 PM
