



## Marlin LeRoy Cobb

August 29, 1937 - March 14, 2023

Marlin LeRoy Cobb, age 85, passed away unexpectedly following an accident on Tuesday, March 14, 2023 at Grand Strand Regional Medical Center.

Born in Franklin, NY, he was a son of the late Tyrus R. Cobb and Beatrice H. Rahlston Cobb. As an IT Tech for several manufacturing companies during his working career, he labored long and hard to provide for his family, spending vacations in Myrtle Beach. Upon retirement, he and his wife, JoAnn landed in Myrtle Beach permanently. He served honorably in the National Guards and was a member of New Life Lutheran Church. Most of all, Marlin was a loving and devoted husband, father, grandfather and doting great grandfather.
