Mrs. Little was born in Conway, a daughter of the late Henry Alton "Slim" and Ruby Lee Causey Alford. She was a member of Wampee Baptist Church where she was a member of the Women's Missionary Union. Mrs. Little was a member very active for many years of the North Myrtle Beach Christian School board. She was a member of several mission trips to Sri Lanka to help with the recovery efforts following the tsunami. Mrs. Little was also traveled with her church family to Greece and Israel, which had a major impact on her life.. She was a former member of Trinity Baptist Church in Kalamazoo, Michigan for many years where she was active in the Women's Missionary Union. Mrs. Little was a Hospice volunteer in Kalamazoo, Michigan. Prior to retirement, she was an IV Technician in Borgess Hospital in Michigan. She and her husband were twice host parents for foreign exchange students, one from Brazil and the other from Korea (Yuni).
