Martha Lou Parnell, better known to family and friends as Marti, passed away peacefully at Grand Strand Regional Medical Center in Myrtle Beach on Thursday, October 15, 2015 after battling cancer.

Marti was born in Huntington, WV, on the sixth day of December, 1956, the daughter of Elizabeth Anne Austin Abott and James Howard Abott.

She graduated from Huntington High in 1973 and attended the Marshall Lab School. A resident of Myrtle Beach since 1974, Marti spent 36 summers welcoming visitors from all over the world to Ocean Lakes Family Campground and the Myrtle Beach Area. Marti trained hundreds of teammates at Ocean Lakes about hospitality and tourism. The guests loved her. She was highly regarded as being honest, ethical, smart and consistent by all those who knew her. Many are struggling in her absence, missing the sounds of her laughter in the hallways, which now seem empty. Marti loved her husband of 23 years, "Harry Bear" and her precious blessing, Bulliet, of 15 years, who guarded her home and heart. She enjoyed the Carolina sunshine sitting in her backyard feeding the ducks or touring around in her VW Beetle convertible, which never saw a speck of dust.

During her career at Ocean Lakes, Marti was recognized as The Jackson Companies 2007 Outstanding Teammate for her remarkable guest service. In 2015, Marti was recognized by Ocean Lakes Family Campground for 35 years of service, having one of the longest tenures at the campground. Marti is predeceased by her parents and survived by her husband, Harry Branford Parnell, Jr., her in-laws, Todd Williams and Jeannie Parnell Williams of Panama City Beach, FL.
