

## Martha Anne Washington

January 6, 1934 - November 28, 2019

Florence, SC.... Dr. Martha Anne Washington, 85, of Florence, S.C. and Athens, Georgia, died on November 28, 2019. She was born in Conway, S.C. on January 6, 1934, a daughter of the late Samuel William Washington, Sr. and Laura Maude Moore Washington. She was a 1952 graduate of Conway High School and graduated from Winthrop College in 1956 with a degree in Health and Physical Education. Marty earned her Masters and Doctoral Degrees in Education from the University of North Carolina at Greensboro. Her teaching career included positions on the faculties at Coker College, Hartsville, S.C., the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill, N.C., and the University of Georgia, Athens, Georgia in the Health and Physical Education Departments. She retired from the University of Georgia in 1996.

Marty served on the Board of the Georgia Association for Health, Physical Education, Recreation, and Dance for several years. She also served on the Board of the Southern Association of Physical Education for College Women. For years, she was extremely active in the American Red Cross Aquatic Programs, contributing over 600 volunteer hours and serving as an invited faculty member of numerous National Red Cross Water Safety and Small Craft Schools.

She was a member of Milledge Avenue Baptist Church in Athens, Georgia, and was a member of the adult choir for many years. Marty was active in the

Pilot Club of Athens, a women's service organization where she held several different positions on the Executive Board.

In 2005 she was the recipient of a Distinguished Alumnae Award by the Department of Physical Education at Winthrop University.

In addition to her parents, Marty was preceded in death by two brothers, Samuel William Washington, Jr. and Robert Landon Washington, Sr. and two sisters, Frances Washington Weeks and Vera Washington Harrelson.

She is survived by seven nieces and nephews, nine great nieces and nephews, eight great great nieces and nephews, and three great great great niece and nephews.

The family will receive friends on Saturday, December 7th from 10:00 A.M. - 11 A.M. at Goldfinch Funeral Home, 606 Beaty Street, Conway, S.C. A memorial service will follow at 11:00 A.M. in the Goldfinch Funeral Home Chapel with the Rev. Rocky Taylor officiating. Burial to follow in Lakeside Cemetery.

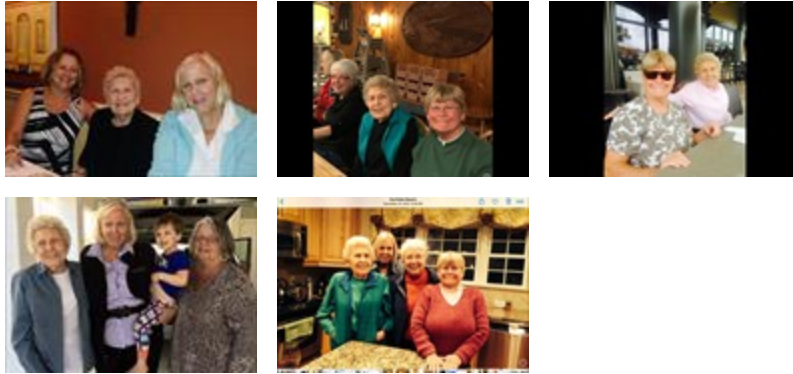
