Martha Elizabeth Watson, age 90, died Sunday, October 6, 2013 at Conway Medical Center.

Born in Stephens City, VA, she was a daughter of the late Charles A. and Courtney Richard. Mrs. Watson worked for the FBI in Washington, DC during WWII and was instrumental in capturing German Spies. She received a personal commendation from J. Edgar Hoover for her efforts. She was active in the Republican Women's Committee and was often a guest in the White House. Mrs. Watson was also on the Women's Committee for The National Symphony Orchestra in Washington DC. She was preceded in death by her husband, Homer C. Watson, Jr. and a daughter, l'Ann W. Blanchette.

Survivors include her daughters, Vikki Miller of Pawleys Island and Christie Watson of Myrtle Beach; a grandson, Matt W. Blanchette of Pawleys Island; and great-grandchildren, Dillon and Lindsey Blanchette.

A graveside service will be held at 1:00 PM Saturday, October 19, 2013 at Green Hill Cemetery in Stephens City, VA.
