Beloved Husband, Father, Grandfather and Great Grandfather, Martin L. Rosol Jr., passed away August 11th, 2023, at 4:00 p.m., surrounded by his immediate family at Waccamaw Community Hospital.

Martin was born in New Britain, CT. After his childhood, he went to prep school at The Taft School in Watertown, CT, before moving on to undergrad study at Yale University. He received his DDS for general dentistry at Columbia University, where he served as the Senior Class President. After 8 years of running his own general practice, his dedication to education continued as he pursued a specialty in orthodontia at Boston University, where he would also accomplish a Master's degree.

Martin is survived by his wife Jeanne Rosol, sons Michael and Mark Rosol, and daughters Jennifer Vanderleeden and Jodi Devine.

Martin was a humble, devout catholic committed to helping others and contributing to his community. He had a lifelong sense of helping others. In retirement, he took his profession and skills and poured his energy into volunteering for children and families who struggled with getting orthodontic care.

When he wasn't working, he was heavily involved with his family. He loved to

fish the Long Island Sound while residing at Groton Long Point, CT, enjoying a good glass of wine, and exploring the world, venturing to many countries with his partner, best-friend and love of his life, Jeanne. He loved frequent visits from his family and lifelong friends during the last years of his life in Pawleys Island, SC, talking about what was happening in their lives, and watching the next generations of his family grow in front of him.

The Rosol family will be hosting a wake in remembrance of his life Tuesday, August 15th between 5 PM and 7 PM at the Goldfinch Funeral Home in Pawleys Island. His service will follow the next day at 10 AM on Wednesday, August 16th with family, friends, and the parishioners of Precious Blood of Christ church, followed by a reception.
