Mary Love Pressly Cameron, 73, died on Wednesday September 23, 2009 in Conway SC. Born in Gastonia, NC, in 1936, Mary Love was the daughter of Dr. James Lowry Pressly and Mary Love Babington Pressly. She lived in Statesville most of her life, donating a portion of the property from her parents' Broad Street home to the town for the construction of Pressly Elementary School. She was educated at Stratford Hall in Danville, VA and Holton-Arms School, formerly in Washington, DC. Mary Love was a Licensed Practical Nurse and worked as a surgical assistant and as a floor nurse at Iredell Memorial Hospital and as an assistant in doctor's offices in South Carolina. She also worked for the American Red Cross. Mary Love was an avid equestrian throughout her youth and early adulthood. In later years, she enjoyed dancing and was a competitive dancer with her Pawley's Island Shag Club. In addition to her parents, Mary Love was preceded in death by her husband, Malcolm Graeme Cameron, formerly of Statesville and lately of Conway, SC. Mary Love is survived by her four children: Richard K. Mattox, J. Pressly Mattox, both of Statesville; Mary Love Mattox of Seattle, WA; and Charles B. Long of Marion, NC.
