May 19, 1947 - January 24, 2023

Mary Alice Driscoll, 75, of Conway, passed away on January 24, 2023, at Conway Medical Center. Mary Alice was born May 19, 1947, in Conway, a daughter of the late Henry B. Brown and Lucy Victoria Alford Brown. In addition to her parents, Mary Alice was preceded in death by her beloved husband, Paul Vincent Driscoll. She was a 1965 graduate of Conway High School and completed her nurse's degree with Hamlet Hospital School of Nursing.

In life, Mary Alice worked as a registered nurse for 42 years. She proudly served her country as a nurse with the US Naval Reserve during the Vietnam conflict. Afterwards, she worked at the Dana Farber Cancer Institute and Lynn Hospital. Eventually, she retired as an IV therapist from Union Hospital. Mary Alice said that her time in Massachusetts was "like 40 years in the wilderness." After retirement, she was grateful to return home to Horry County to be near her family.

Her friends and family knew Mary Alice to be a very loving and caring person who had her mother's sense of humor and her father's generosity. Mary Alice enjoyed nature and loved all animals, especially cats. She is survived by her devoted sister, Iris Brown, and special cousins Harold and Geanean Brown, along with countless other extended family members and many friends who will miss her dearly.

A graveside memorial service to honor Mary Alice will be held on Thursday, February 9, at 2:00 PM, at State Branch Cemetery in Conway on Beverly Road, with Pastor Robbin King officiating. Immediately following the service, a reception will be held for family and friends and the Pauley Swamp Baptist Church in Conway.
