Mary Jane Allen Magrath of Conway, South Carolina, passed away on June 6, 2025.

She was born on January 6, 1927 in Dillon, South Carolina. She was the daughter of the late Sen. David Smith Allen and Lila Rebecca McIntyre Allen. She was the wife of the now deceased George N. Magrath for fifty-eight years. Mrs. Magrath was a graduate of Winthrop College and taught at Conway High School. She later served on the Winthrop Alumni Council. She was a member of Kingston Presbyterian Church for seventy-seven years and a member of the Janette Quattlebaum Circle. She was a charter member of the Chicora Chapter of the Colonial Dames XVII Century and a member of the Peter Horry Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution. For many years she was an avid golf and bridge player.
