She used this skill to play organ and piano in church during services and was active in other church functions. She completed High School with high marks. She worked at General Electric during World War II working on critical wiring for radar systems. She left G.E. to enlist in the WAC (Women Army Corp). She served in several Army Hospital in the States in a medical responsibility, and achieved the rank of Technical Sargent. It was, at one of these hospitals, Brook General in San Antonio, Texas where she met her future husband, William C. Trier (Bill) who had just flown in from Japan as a patient to Brook General. They both met and married in June 7, 1947. Upon leaving the Army she and husband settled down in Schenectay, NY her home town to raise a family. Maryin became a Licensed Practical Nurse and practiced in several area hospitals notably Ellis Hospital and Glenridge Hospital a one- time TB Treatment facility and graduated to Lung Care Center. She was a member of St. Michael's Catholic Church in Garden City, SC. Her great love was playing bridge. She played with groups and friends. She is loved by all who knew her especially her family. She will be missed. Survivors include three children, Bruce, Christine and Eric; five grandchildren, Rachael, Melissa, Lauren, Jason and Joshua and

three great-grandchildren, Seth, Brett and Kendall. A memorial mass will be held at 9:30 AM Wednesday, September 16, 2009 at St. Michaels Catholic Church with Father Ray Carlo officiating.
