In later life, she fell in love again and married the Rev. A.D. Grainger of Conway, who also predeceased her.

In more recent years, she took great joy in being able to rejoin Mt. Zion Baptist Church, the church in which she was raised as a child. On most days, you could find her out enjoying lunch at Webster's or Cracker Barrel and then shopping.
