Michael R. Gray, of Murrells Inlet, SC passed away on December 17, 2019 after a short illness.

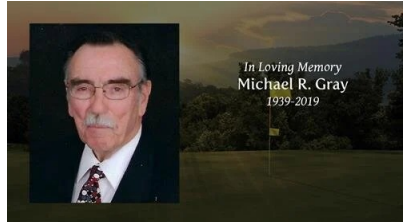
