Michael Stuart Jones, age 58, of Surfside Beach, passed away Friday, April 21, 2023 at McLeod Seacoast Hospital.

Mike was born August 9, 1964 in East Point, Georgia to the late Ken and Sue Jones. He is a 1982 graduate of Morrow High School and a 1986 graduate of the University of South Carolina. In 2016, he received the Distinguished Service Award for the South Carolina Band Directors Association, in which he was Chairman of Region 5 for 25 years. Mike was also a member of Phi Beta Mu where he served as its Executive Secretary/Treasurer for many years.

Mike continued to play trumpet and conduct for the Pawley Island Community Concert Band. He was also member of the Florence Community Band, Palmetto Concert Band, and a brass quintet. In addition, he enjoyed playing in a rock band called Speakeasy.

He is survived by his brother Todd Jones and his wife, Kristi; nephew Tyler Jones, niece Kelsi Jones and many other loving family members. Mike has also been surrounded by a large group of loving friends he considered his extended family.

A visitation with the family will be 4-6pm, Tuesday April 25, 2023 at Goldfinch Funeral Home, Beach Chapel. A graveside service will be held Thursday, April 27, 2023 at 11am at College Park Cemetery in College Park, GA. There will also be a celebration of live event to honor Mike at a later date.
