Mildred Case Holmes, 94, of Little River and Darlington, SC, passed away peacefully on October 26, 2016. She was born August 20, 1922, in Chadbourn, NC, to the late Homer and Mollie Edge Case. As a young child, she moved with her family to North Myrtle Beach, SC, where she lived much of her life. She is predeceased by her husband of 65 years, Henry H.
