“ Dear Posek Family, The notice published in the Post-Dispatch brought back a flood of happy memories. When my brother, Arnold, and I ("Duke") were little boys in wartime Affton, my mom, Helene Dill, was a full time homemaker but actively involved in a host of local and Parish activities. Mrs. Hertel, Hilda, was well known to my parents and she became Mom's housekeeping helper. For years, at least weekly, we would drive down Heege Road to Mrs. Hertel's home to pick her up to help at home. Later, she moved to Laclede Station Road and continued to help Mom for many years. Hilda truly became and was always thought of as a member of our family. Mildred and, later, Joe were always a part of the picture. They, I believe, lived down New Hampshire Ave. near us and we were, with them, parishioners at Seven Holy Founders Parish for some years. After I grew up and started a legal practice, I believe I had the pleasure of doing some basic legal planning for Joe & Mildred. Their three sons, much younger than me, were their pride and joy. I was slightly acquainted with them, but never became close friends. I was the volunteer lawyer who worked with Mr. Jake Gass and others to create the Affton Historical Society which acquired and restored historic "Oakland" House in Lakewood. Mildred's devotion and loyalty to that effort was well known and highly valued. Grandma Hilda" was a wonderful lady and Millie was certainly her equal.
