Milo E. Myers, 84 of Horry County, died Tuesday, May 20, 2014 at Veterans Victory House in Walterboro, SC.

Born in Jasper County, Illinois, he was the son of the late James and Bertha Myers. He was a graduate of the University of Illinois at Champaign. Mr. Myers was a retired B-58 Air Force pilot and later served in the Vietnam War. He was a longtime resident of the Murrells Inlet and surrounding area where he was part owner of the Brookwood Motel and Captain Dicks Marina where he had a shrimping, touring and charter fishing boat fleet. He started a marine construction company on the Grand Strand in the early 70's which is still active today. Among his many activities he loved the beach, tennis, golf and was an avid fisherman. His wife, Bobbie Farr Myers, sister, Ilene Drollinger and sons, Steven and Randy Myers all preceded him in death.
