Myron Harvist of Murrells Inlet, SC, passed away on December 3, 2024 at the age of 77, surrounded by his loving wife and daughters at MUSC Hospital in Charleston. Born on October 19, 1947, in Pottsville, PA, to the late Metro and Mary Harvist, Myron and his family moved to New Jersey, where he graduated from Bridgewater Raritan High School West in 1965. He later earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Computer Science/Information Systems from Rutgers University while working full-time. He enjoyed a successful career as a programmer and consultant at Warner Lambert and Munics Information Systems, retiring in 2017.

A passionate golfer, Myron was drawn to the sunny shores (and lower taxes) of South Carolina in 2009 where he played golf, pickleball, and swam at the nearby beach or pool. He was a member of St. Michael's Catholic Church and served on the board of the Sweetwater Condominium Homeowners Association. Myron loved telling jokes and was delighted by a good

bargain, but most of all, he enjoyed connecting with family and friends.
