Conway.... Rev. Neigel Scarborough, age 82, passed away Sunday, November 8, 2020.

Rev. Scarborough was born in Greenville, SC a son of the late Paul Scarborough and Elzora Duvall Scarborough. He was an Air Force veteran. Mr. Scarborough attended Mars Hill College and the University of South Carolina where he earned his BS degree in Business and graduated from ORU with his PhD in Theology. He was employed with FDIC as a bank examiner prior to his calling into the ministry. Rev. Scarborough married the love of his life in 1969. He served for 51 years in the ministry with the Church of God (1969 until 2020). Rev. Scarborough pastored 10 churches in the cities of Los Angeles, CA, Springfield, MO, Tulsa, OK, Soddy Daisy, TN, Memphis, TN, Tustin, CA, Troy, MI, Syracuse, NY, Miramar, FL, and Myrtle Beach, SC. Rev. Scarborough also served as a State Evangelism and Youth Director in Southern California and as the Dean of Students of the Church of God, School of Theology in Cleveland, TN. He enjoyed golfing, fishing, and people.

Surviving are his wife of 51 years, Peggy Scarborough of Myrtle Beach; a daughter, Sherri Scarborough; a brother, Sherrill Scarborough (Linda); and a sister, Marcelle McCroskey (Mike).
