Murrells Inlet Neil A. McEachren age 74, died Monday, December 14, 2009 at his home in Wachesaw Plantation. Neil was born October 31, 1935 in Fairport, NY. Neil graduated from Manlius Military School, Brown University, where he was a member of the Phi Gamma Delta Fraternity and a member of the Brown Football Team.
