Nelson Faulks Newcomb age 87, died Monday, March 26, 2012 at Tideland Community Hospice House.

Born in Elizabeth, NJ, he was a son of the late Everett and Marion Newcomb. Mr. Newcomb was a graduate of Washington and Lee University where he lettered in baseball. Mr. Newcomb enlisted in the United States Navy on January 6, 1943 where he served in the Pacific; he was discharged August of 1947 as a Lt. JG. He was signed by the St. Louis Browns Baseball Organization as a pitcher. He owned and operated Pick Point Lodge with his entire family in Tuftonboro, NH on the shores of Lake Winnepesaukee for over 40 years. He invented several products with his son Corky; they ran Pick Point Sports together where they invented unique sport products including the Nitelite Golfball, the Nitelite Football, and the Automatic Curveball. He loved golf, tennis, baseball and his dogs.

Survivors include his wife, Sara Newcomb of Myrtle Beach; three sons, Corky (Betsey), Dick (Marcia) and Jeffrey (Adriana) Newcomb; five grandchildren, Buck Newcomb (Stephi), Heather Newcomb, Brett Newcomb, Sarah Newcomb and David Mesa; stepson, Sam (Sherry) Singleton and their sons Joe and Bobby and stepson, Kent Singleton and a great grandson, Alex

Christopher Garrett.
