Norman “Norm” William Neubauer, 86, died Monday, July 29, 2024 at his residence.

Born in Staten Island, NY, he was the son of the late Andrew R. Neubauer and Anna M. Donovan. He was preceded in death by his wife Otilie “Lee” of 45 years, his brothers George Neubauer and Raymond Neubauer.

Norm graduated from the Augustinian Academy in Staten Island, NY and then served 4 years as military police in the Air Force. He then began his career with J. P. Morgan Bank which spanned 33 years, retiring as a Vice President of Special Collections in their private bank. He also graduated from Saint Peters University in Jersey City, NJ with a BS in Business. He took great pride in his work with the bank and enjoyed traveling the world. Notable projects were the sale of the Virgil M. Brand coin collection in 1983 which was the largest private coin collection ever formed by a single individual. Mr. Neubauer later formed a consulting firm, SomersArt, with his wife Lee that was instrumental in the sale of the George Costakis Avante Guard collection. Later in life he became an active member in the Knights of Columbus.

Norm enjoyed traveling, golfing, keeping his mind active in the stock market and most of all being a connector who always kept in touch with his family and friends. Those who knew him will miss his laugh and the ever present twinkle in his eye.

Survivors include his three daughters Michele Neubauer and her partner Jeff, Suzanne Freitag and her husband Rich, and Jennifer Neubauer; two grandchildren Lauren Freitag and Bradley Freitag; his partner of 13 years, Glenda Taylor; her daughter Olivia Ozycz, husband Greg and their children Teddy and Ruby as well as nieces and nephews.

A mass and entombment will be held at Precious Blood of Christ Church in Pawleys Island, SC. on August 10, 2024 at 11:30 am.
