MURRELLS INLET | Ollie Lucille May, age 84, a retired employee of the U.S. General Accounting Office, died Sunday, September 23, 2007 at Tideland Community Hospice House in Georgetown. Mrs. May was born in Chester County, Pennsylvania, March 30, 1923, the daughter of the late Jess and Laura Bessie Dean Monger and raised in McGaheysville, Va. She was a graduate of Blacksburg High School, Blacksburg, Va. She attended Strayer's College in Washington D.C. Mrs. May lived in Blacksburg, Va., Washington, D.C. and Northern Virginia before moving back to McGaheysville, Va. She was a member of McGaheysville United Methodist Church. She was a board trustee, did the layout for the monthly bulletin, and worked in the clothes closet. Mrs. May worked as an illustrator, statistical draftsman, forms designer, and engineering draftsman at the Naval Gun Factory, Military Sea Transportation Service, Defense Documentation Center and the U.S. General Accounting Office until retiring in June of 1972 because of ill health, after twenty-seven and a half years of service. Mrs. May received a number of awards for outstanding service. She would be sent to Capital Hill for work there as she was cleared for top secret work. She married C. Howard May on February 6, 1941, who died January 9, 1969. Mrs. May is survived by one daughter, Doris M. Campbell of Murrells Inlet; one grandson, Adam B. Campbell of Murrells Inlet; and her half-sister, Nora Welch of Salem, Va. Kyger Funeral Home in Elkton, Va. is handling the arrangements.
