Otto Louis Jansky, Jr., age 90, passed away on April 8, 2025, at Magnolia Bridge at Murrells Inlet with his family by his side.

Otto's life touched everyone who knew him. He was a humble, kind, and generous man with a quick wit and a great sense of humor.
