Palmer Alexander Surfside Beach Palmer Alexander age 83, formerly of Winston-Salem, NC died Tuesday, January 27, 2009 at his residence. Mr. Alexander was born on August 12, 1925 in Statesville, NC. Mr. Alexander attended Surfside Methodist Church. At an early age, Mr. Alexander was employed by the U.S. Government in Washington, DC in the Military Intelligence Service until 1943. He was a veteran of World War II, having served in the China/Burma India Theater with the 3rd Army Headquarters Military Intelligence from 1943-1948. After leaving the Army, Mr. Alexander worked for IBM from 1948-1950 in Winston-Salem, NC. On June 24, 1950, he married Geraldine Jerri Brown. That same year, he started and managed the Data Processing Department of Piedmont Airlines. He retired from Piedmont Airlines after 30 years of service and moved to Surfside Beach, SC with his wife, Jerri. Surviving is his wife, Jerri Alexander and a brother, Omer Alexander and wife, Phyllis of Stony Point, NC. Also surviving are two special nephews, Michael Phillip Brown and wife Marjorie of Belleville, NJ and Thomas M. Brown and wife Cameron of Winston-Salem, NC. A memorial service will be held at 11:00 A.M. Friday, January 30, 2009 at Surfside Methodist Church with Dr. Scott Wachter officiating.
