Mrs. Patricia "Mimi" Edgar, 86, wife of 59 years to C. Lawton Edgar, of the Socastee community, passed away Thursday, June 04, 2015 at Waccamaw Community Hospital.

She was born December 19, 1928 in Boston, Massachusetts, a daughter of the late George Edward Everett Litchfield and Sarah Dorothy Connolly Litchfield. She was a bookkeeper for Plantation Resort in Myrtle Beach for 25 years and retired at age 80. 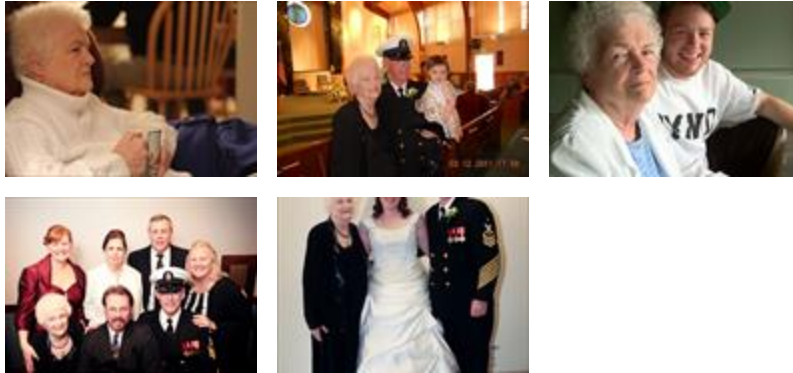
