Patricia (Pat) O'Donnell Hardwick, age 74, of Conway, SC entered eternal rest on Friday, October 18, 2024 at Conway Medical Center after a brief illness. Pat was born in Detroit, Michigan to Charles R. and Margaret Lester Givens O'Donnell. The O'Donnell Family moved to Murfreesboro, Tennessee where Pat lived most of her youth and young adult life. Her family moved to Myrtle Beach when Pat was in high school. Pat is a graduate of Coastal Carolina University with a Bachelor of Science in Accounting. While at Coastal, she was also a cheerleader for the Chanticleers. She was a brilliant lady who easily impressed her superiors with her intellect, dedication, and initiative.

Pat was employed as an Accountant with Horry County Schools for a number of years and there met the love of her life. She and Harrell were married on October 24, 1981 and were just 6 days short of celebrating their 43rd wedding anniversary. They were one another's soulmate throughout their many years together.

She was always a jokester and thoroughly enjoyed embarrassing others with her antics. Her favorite holiday was Halloween, wherein she would annually dress up and bring lots of laughter and cheer to all the neighborhood children.
