Patricia Mary (Hawkins) Dorfer passed away on November 4, 2024, peacefully after a brief illness at Tidelands Health Hospital in Murrells Inlet, SC.

Pat spent many enjoyable days swimming in her community pool, caring for the cleanliness of all the outside furniture and urging all swimmers and guests to adhere to pool rules and policies. Pat loved the ocean, walking endlessly while tossing stones with encouraging spiritual words on each into the ocean. She often noticed these same stones being found by people many days, weeks, and even months later- always amazing to those who discovered them; often a personal and deep meaning in their find. Brookgreen Gardens might be considered, along with the ocean, her favored destinations for meditation. Pat, often thought to be stoic and stringent to many, had the most beautiful, sensitive, and comforting side. Her poems and prose are

mesmerizing; absolutely unforgettable. An avid reader, she owned virtually all hardcover books by her favorite authors. Pat also enjoyed hosting annual holiday brunches with friends. Pat founded "The Survivors of Suicide" group after Gregory's death and has held monthly meetings for nearly twenty years. This group served to give comfort and support to so many over these years. Pat and Greg worked in the food industry beginning in Long Island, followed by similar work in Hornell, NY. They moved to Murrells Inlet more than twenty years ago. Pat continued her food services career at Cracker Barrel as a cook until her retirement.

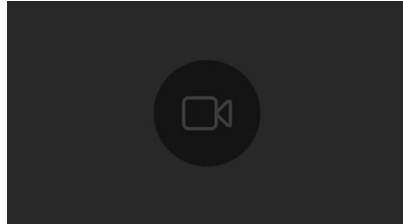
