“ Ken,

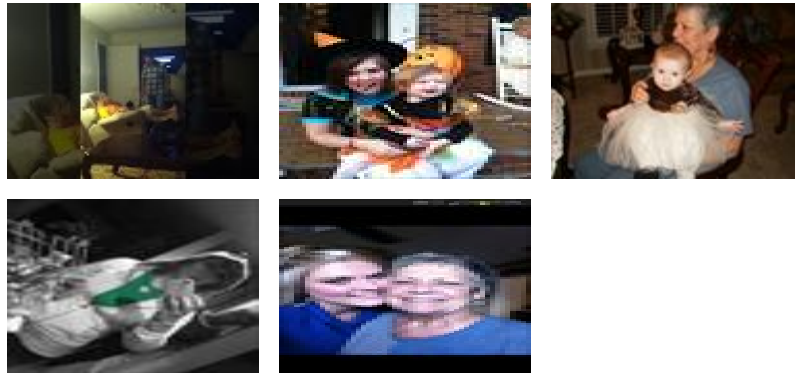
