Mr. Patrick J. Argento, 92, widower of the late Gloria E. Argento, passed away Thursday, February 23, 2017 at Grand Strand Regional Medical Center in Myrtle Beach, SC.

Born December 13, 1924, in Brooklyn, NY, Mr. Argento was the son of the late Rocco "Robert" Argento and the late Vita "Eva" Lombardino Argento. He and his late wife, Gloria E. Argento, were members of the Catholic Church of St. James in Conway, SC and St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Bay Shore, NY.
