Pat D'Anna, 81, died at home after a long and valiant battle with Parkinson's disease.

He and Nancy loved to travel, and enjoyed trips to Italy, Alaska, most of the

Most importantly he was a good man. He loved his family and especially loved spending time drinking vanilla milk shakes with his 3 great grandsons.

His faith in God was strong and unwavering and he endured his health issues bravely, knowing he would someday be whole again in Christ.

Pat leaves behind to cherish his memory his wife and love of his life, Nancy, three children including his beloved daughter Vicki Levy of Socastee, 6 grand children, 5 great grandchildren, and 2 "bonus" children, Kristi Padgett and Michael Tolley, who he loved like his own. Pat was predeceased by his brother John D'Anna and sister Mary Ann Capannola.
