Myrtle Beach...Peggy Jo Hardee Rabon, age 81, of South Oak Street, died Sunday, August 31, 2014 at her residence.

Mrs. Rabon was born in Horry County, a daughter of the late Joe Cephus and Maude Anderson Hardee. She was a member of Socastee Baptist Church and was a former member of First Baptist Church in Myrtle Beach. Prior to retirement, she was employed by Horry County Schools as a teacher, teaching at Socastee High School for 17 years and then Myrtle Beach Middle School for 14 years. Mrs. Rabon has been the owner of the Sea Palms Motel since 1977.

Surviving are one son, Jack Isaiah Rabon, Jr. and wife Nicole of Myrtle Beach, one daughter, Karon Rabon Mitchell and husband Kyle of Myrtle Beach, two grandsons, Chad Mitchell and wife Leigh Anna and Chase Mitchell, all of Myrtle Beach.

Funeral services will be held at 5:00 PM Thursday at Cool Springs Southern Methodist Church with Dr. Wayne Brown officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery directed by Goldfinch Funeral Home, Conway Chapel.

The family will receive friends from 5:00 PM until 8:00 PM Wednesday at the residence on South Oak St. and from 4:00 PM until 5:00 PM Thursday at the church fellowship hall.
