Mr. Weant was employed by the Carolina Motor Club in Charlotte, NC until he joined the U.S. Navy and served as a Chief Petty Officer in WWII and Korea. He was Vice President, Sales Manager of Piedmont Equipment Co., Inc. in Charlotte for 25 years. He was founder of Autohardware, Inc. and was President of this company until he sold the business in 1982 and retired to Surfside Beach. Mr. Weant was a member of Shepherd of the Sea Lutheran Church in Garden City, SC, a member of Joppa Lodge No. 530, a 32nd Degree Scottish Rite Mason, and a member of Oasis Temple of Charlotte. He was also a charter member of Post 7735 Veterans of Foreign Wars. He is preceded in death by his son, Ernest Paul Weant of Lilburn, GA. and a brother, George Owen Weant of Stanley, NC. He is survived by his wife Sarah Biggers Weant of 65 years, his daughter-in-law, Lois A.
