Peter Vincent Moulder, Jr. MD. Peter Vincent Moulder, Jr. MD. age 89, of the Lakes at Litchfield, died Monday, May 10, 2010 at Waccamaw Community Hospital. Born on January 26, 1921 he was a son of the late Marcella and Peter Vincent Moulder, Sr. Dr. Moulder was a U.S. Navy WWII veteran. He received his BS magna cum Laude, at the University Notre Dame in 1942.
