Tomlinson, MD; two sons: Alfred Jason Tomlinson, and Andrew John Tomlinson of Myrtle Beach; one daughter, Sherri Lynn Tomlinson of Myrtle Beach; one brother, Anthony Paul Albanese, MD of El Dorado Hills, California; Father-In-Law, A. Jess Tomlinson of Surfside Beach; Stepmother-In-Law, Margaret Tomlinson of Surfside Beach; an aunt, Eleanor Brunetto of Myrtle Beach. 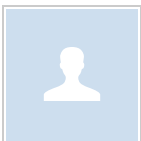

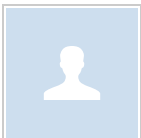

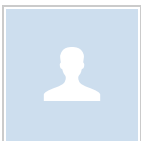
